CompuMentur Proposal to the Peninsula Community Foundation Bay Area Services Initiative

1. Proposal Summary

CompuMentor respectfully requests \$50,000 to provide a suite of technical support services known as the Bay Area Services initiative, enabling 20 small non-profit organizations (ranging in size from \$100,000-\$1,000,000) in San Mateo and Northern Santa Clara Counties to effectively use technology as a tool in program management and evaluation. The program timeline is April 1, 2017 through March 31, 2018.

Most non-profits struggle with a variety of technical needs. Database planning and development is the most crucial of these needs, because it is central to a non-profit's ability to track and report on client outcomes. It is also the most challenging, due to a shortage of high quality, low cost technical support services available to non-profit organizations in the Bay Area.

CompuMentor's Bay Area Services initiative will address the unmet technical needs of selected nonprofits by providing services in Network Installation, Scheduled Support, Database Planning, Database Implementation, and Implementation Support Services, including basic technical planning, mentor matching, and technology information and referral services through our TechSoup/Bay Area program.
